



Welcome to Föglö!

Facts

Föglö is Åland's largest archipelago municipality with approx. 500 permanent residents and 700 holiday homes.

Degerby developed from the 15th century onwards, mainly due to the vicinity of the fairway and through customs, pilotage, inns, and trade. The traces are still there: The small customs warehouses – today the museum; The customs janitor's home – today tourist information and library. If you want to experience more of the Föglö's history, we recommend a visit to one of the museums, or by taking a walk in picturesque Degerby among all of the old houses.

Welcome to Degerby 23rd of July enroute to Mariehamn

Every Tuesday is market-night in Degerby during the summer, with local merchants of all sorts. This night is of course special for the village, welcoming your ships! There will be entertainment and activities in the spirit of sailors. At nearby Restaurant Seagram there will be live-music during the evening, cold beverages, local delicacies or pizza for those who prefer that.

Around the harbor you'll find the tourist information who will show you everything you need to know about the service house and service kitchen. You also find the Föglö museum, pilot's museum, library, flea markets, supermarket, miniature golf, the old courthouse Enigheten (which today is a B&B and restaurant) and Badhotell Carlsro (hotel, café, shop & beach bar).

There will be a guided tour around Degerby with our talented guide Katarina Mörn.

Explore Föglö

If you rent a bike at the supermarket/harbor office or rent a cab, you could discover more of our island! Föglö's church, dedicated to St. Mary Magdalene, is located next to Kyrksundet. The oldest part of the church is estimated to date from the 14th century. In Västersocken you will find Hummersö which is a bit of Föglös cultural center. Here you will find the museum Mattsmårs, Galleri Berghäll and La Bibloteca Senza Frontiere. At Östersocken you will find farms that are open for visits, garden cafes and garden shops. Föglö offers two public beaches, Sinting which is located in Degerby and the other is in Hastersboda. At Föglö you will find two of Åland's most beautiful hiking trails. The Jyddö trail (5km) offers rare flora and several resting places. The Hastersboda trail (4km) partly runs together with the disc golf course. Here you can enjoy both cliffs and old forest.
