Port Description and General Information

The charming Nagu was the 1st classified IMCI-harbour in Scandinavia. Its services are regions best: Bank (Cash Point), Post, Pharmacy, Health center, Hotels, BBs, Restaurants, Cafeterias, Stores, Liquor store, Shops, Selling lofts, Market place, Galleries, Maritime House ('Museum'), After sail bar / Pizzeria / Disco, etc. And 7 daily return busses to the mainland Turku & Helsinki.

The largest brackish water Archipelago in the World with some 100'000 islands (= 'Central Baltic Region' in EU) is located in Finland, Sweden and Estonia. Its service hub **Nagu** lies 200 km E of Stockholm, 200 km W of Helsinki, and 50 km SW of Turku. This 'Summer Capital' of the **Town of Pargas** has 1300 stationary inhabitants from over 20 nationalities, of whom 75% speak Swedish while the rest speak Finnish. Almost all of them do speak **English**.

To Experience

- The Medieval Stone Church of Nagu is dedicated to the Norwegian viking king St Olof (r. 1015-30), the protector of all sailors, and St Erik of Sweden (r. 1156-60). Foundation of an older wooden church (13th C) can be seen in the N aisle. Sacristy is the oldest standing part (14th C), while the rest was built during the 15th C. The over seas pilgrim route St Olav Waterway from Turku via Nagu to the Åland islands, and further to Sweden and Norway was opened in 2019. It has the status of a Cultural Route of the Council of Europe.
- **The Schwan Organ** in the Church is the biggest and best preserved from the 18th C in Finland (repaired in 2014) the acoustics in the church is excellent.
- The Maritime House of Nagu (2010-) tells about several Nagu-based international shipping companies, and shows some of the model ships, made by master Åke Sandvall (1920–93): traditional vessels, votive ships (e.g. in the Cathedral of Turku, and Church of Nagu), and industrial models. Nagu was the leading sailing municipality in Finland in the end of the 19thC.

Three Ports of Nagu

- 1) South Harbor at the Market Place is for small motorboats (dist. 0,3 km).
- 2) East Harbor for docking, repairing and winter-storing of boats (dist. 1,5 km).
- 3) **North Harbor** is one of the best-equipped and most popular visiting harbors in Finland, with over 50'000 yearly sailors, incl. 40% day-visitors. It contains shops, incl. smoked fish shop, fish bistro, pizzerias, cafeterias, <u>crews' saunas</u>, laundry, waste centre, canoe & bicycle rental, fuel station with outfit
- and beaches with open fire places and beach yoga, Sail in Church, etc.
